I will be professional and show respect to the umpire when disputing decisions he/she has made.

I will not make negative comments to the umpire while on the field or bench.

I will, to the best of my ability, help my team develop their skills and abilities.

I will ensure that my players are in a safe and healthy environment.

I understand that all coaches and executives of the Quinte Royals Baseball Association are all volunteers and will address all concerns/issues in a discreet location away from the players.

I will do my best to ensure every player has a great season of baseball.

I will not make comments to spectators during the game.

When faced with difficult or sensitive discussions, I will follow the '24-hour rule', when applicable.

I understand I need to have a clear criminal record check.

I understand I, or a representative of my team will attend Royals Executive Meetings.

I understand I must be certified via Ontario Baseball Association and will attend all required coaching clinics.
