2017 Umpire Policy

Coaches and/or managers are required to add all home games to the website.

Umpires are to request games via the Quinte Royals website, quinteroyals.com. The Umpire in Chief will communicate the date in which registration is available. All umpires must be registered via the site and should ensure their profile has accurate email and phone numbers, as the coaches/managers will refer to this information when attempting to contact them.

Umpires will be approved by the Umpire in Chief.

Umpires will adhere to all **EOBA** and **OBA** rules of play. Umpires are required to follow policy for reporting ejections.

Umpire Fees are as follows:

(Fees are to be paid monthly unless otherwise agreed.) Email quinteroyals@gmail.com if you would like to amend the payment schedule.

A 'double' game exists when an individual umps consecutive games with approximately an hour between games. A double game scenario could exist with different teams; if the rates differ, an average of the pay rates will be paid. Travel costs are included in the fees.

Cancellations:

If a cancellation is made 48 hours prior to the start of a game, and the change is reflected on the team schedule, the coach and/or manager is not obligated to contact the umpire. Umpires are responsible to review their schedule 24 hours prior to any upcoming game.

In the event a game needs to be cancelled, assigned umpires are to be notified **2 hours before** the scheduled game time. No fee will be charged, on the condition of the following.

The coach or manager must communicate the cancellation by contacting the umpire directly, using at least two different types of communication (call, text or email). Coaches and/or managers will be provided contact information from the site.

If the coach and/or manager cannot reach the umpire directly, they should inform the Umpire in Chief.

If these conditions have not been met, and the umpire appears at the diamond, the team will be responsible for paying the umpire. If there is a double-header, only a single game rate will be paid.

Umpires are encouraged to check their email, texts and voice mail messages within two hours (or more) of scheduled games. A lack of payment will result when the policy has been followed by the coaches and/or managers.
